- Exposure to fitness, medical & personal development > AFL recognised as world leaders in • many of these.

- Academy "High Performance Squad" made up of 16-19 players that are deemed to have some AFL level attributes
- Select 17-19yr old's can play in our Lions NEAFL team alongside, and against AFL players









AFL DRUG POLICY

• AFL clubs & players are required to use supplements that have been batch tested & approved under the

 Any player purchasing supplements over the internet from overseas risks being identified by Australian **Customs and referred to ASADA for investigation** with the likely outcome to be a sanction under the AFL

• You do not have to be tested to breach the code and receive a sanction, and sanctions under the AFL Anti-Doping Code can be up to four years and prevent a person from performing any role at any sporting club

WIDE BAY = Childers Showgrounds & State High School (Bundaberg, Hervey Bay, Maryborough, Childers, Burnett areas)
