
Vale Tony Ongarello

The Brisbane Lions are mourning the loss of former Fitzroy full-forward **Tony Ongarello** who sadly passed away last month at the age of 89.

'Onga' played 131 matches and kicked 247 goals in a career with Fitzroy that spanned nine years (1952-60).

A three-time leading goal-kicker at the Club, he is famous for being the last footballer in V/AFL history to register a goal using the old place kick.

This year will mark the 20-year anniversary of the Lions' nine -point Grand Final victory over Collingwood - the second of three successive flags achieved by the Club.


Plans are also being discussed for a proposed event in 2023 that will bring players, coaches, members and supporters together for a monumental Three-Peat celebration.

All-Aussie Lachie

Star Brisbane Lions midfielder **Lachie Neale** claimed his third All-Australian blazer last week at the AFL Awards.

Neale, who also earned All-Australian selection in both 2019 and 2020, has been a standout for the Lions this season averaging 30.1 disposals per game.
