1. Competition Period

The competition opens upon venue gates opening for the Brisbane Lions AFLW Round 6 match versus Adelaide Crows at Brighton Homes Arena and closes at the commencement of the match at **5:05pm AEST** on the day of the game.

Entries received after 5:05pm AEST will not be accepted.

2. Eligibility

Entry is open to individuals aged 18 years or over at the time of entry.

The following persons are ineligible:

- Employees, directors and officers of the Promoter;
- Employees, directors and officers of the AFL;
- Players and registered officials of the Brisbane Lions;
- Contractors, agencies or suppliers associated with this competition; and
- Immediate family members of any of the above.

"Immediate family" includes spouse, de facto spouse, child, parent, sibling or other close relative.

The Promoter reserves the right to verify eligibility and disqualify any entrant who does not meet these criteria.

There is no cost to enter.

3. How to Enter

To enter, an eligible entrant must, during the Competition Period:

1. Attend the Brisbane Lions AFLW Round 6 match versus Adelaide Crows at Brighton Homes Arena; and

2. Complete and submit the official competition entry form by scanning one of the QR codes displayed throughout Brighton Homes Arena and providing the required contact details.

Limit of one (1) entry per person.

The Promoter accepts no responsibility for late, lost, misdirected, incomplete or corrupted entries.

4. Prize

There is one (1) prize:

Two (2) tickets to the 2026 Toyota AFL Grand Final.

The prize includes tickets only.

The prize does **not** include flights, accommodation, travel, meals, merchandise, spending money or any other associated costs, which are the sole responsibility of the winner.

Tickets are subject to AFL ticketing terms and conditions, venue conditions of entry and any allocation limitations imposed by the AFL.

If the AFL Grand Final is postponed, cancelled, relocated or ticket allocation is withdrawn or reduced by the AFL for any reason, the Promoter is not liable and may substitute the prize with a prize of equal or greater value (subject to applicable regulatory requirements).

5. Winner Selection, Notification and Claim

The draw will take place immediately following the close of entries at 5:05pm AEST.

The winner will be notified by email and/or phone within one (1) hour of the draw.
